ASSOCIATION MEMBER CONFERENCE SUPPORT

At a recent BCTF Board meeting we reviewed the conference support project that was introduced for the first year early in 2024. The feedback we have received from this project was that this support was highly valued, especially at a time when the construction industry is at lower levels and sponsorship is not necessarily forthcoming or harder to secure.

The Board has therefore agreed to renew this support for 2025 at an increased level of \$20,000 per event. The details and terms of this support (including an updated application form) will be released in January 2025.
